Installation

KWDAMP Series Fixed-blade Dampers should be installed as close to the boiler outlet as required, with sufficient clearance to allow for proper access and operation of the manual hand quadrant. Once the vent system has been properly balanced, the damper is permanently fixed into position and will restrict the flow of flue gases as needed. A built in fail-safe feature ensures the damper will remain open in the event of damage to the manual hand quadrant or lock nut.

Important

The max rated temperature for the fixed blade damper is 392°F (200°C). When used, the entire vent system must be de-rated in maximum temperature to this value. Always follow appliance manufacturer's installation instructions for proper appliance setup and venting requirements.
